



## Dream Guitars - Installation

1. Download the two .zip files for the library
2. Create a local folder and unzip the above files into it
3. At the end of the unzip process you should have the following folder structure (respecting this structure you will avoid any missing samples message in Kontakt)
  - a) a "Samples" folder
  - b) an "Instruments" folder
  - c) two additional files ("Dream\_Guitar.nkr" and "Dream\_Guitar.nkc")

So basically the folder should look like this

```

To load the patches just pick your patch from the "Instruments" folder using the Browser Tab of your Kontakt and drag the patch into Kontakt.

# Dream Guitars - the GUI

ADSR envelope for Low Pass Filter. The "Env" switch activates this envelope. Parameters are Attack, decay, sustain and release

ADSR envelope for Volume. Parameters are Attack, decay, sustain and release

4 poles Low Pass Filter with Cutoff and Resonance control. The "env" switch activates the envelope control for this filter



High Pass Filter with Cutoff and Resonance control. Use the cutoff control to roll off some bass if needed

Stereo width and pan control. when set to far left field is mono, when far right applies stereo enhancement

Reverb effect. Controls set amount and reverb sizes

Luminance applies a set of designed impulses to the overall patch.

Rotator applies a Leslie-like effect. Amount sets the effect mix, Speed sets the rotation speed, Tone sets the overall tone of the effect and Distance sets the distance from the emulated speaker

Rhythmizer applies rhythmic patterns to the sound. Type sets the pattern type (there are 12) and amount sets the amount of modulation applied

Delay effect. Tempo Synced. Amount sets the delay mix and time sets delay time.
