



Hi

Thanks for buying Cloud Viola², I hope you will have a lot of fun together.

The best way to get up and running is...

1. If you don't have one already make a Sound Dust folder on your sample drive.
2. Make a Cloud Viola folder inside the Sound Dust folder (not essential but good to keep things tidy)
3. Extract all the downloaded files into the new Cloud Viola folder.

4. Follow the Snapshot installation instructions shown below.

5. Once you have installed the snapshots open Kontakt and use the 'Files' tab to locate the Cloud Viola folder you just made.

6. Inside the folder you will find the instrument - 'Cloud Viola2 _SOUND DUST.nki' file.

7. To load an instrument either double click or drag the file into the main Kontakt pane.

If Kontakt says it can't find the sample files use the browse function to point it to the 'Cloud Viola2 _SOUND DUST Samples' folder in your Clod Viola' folder and once it has loaded save the instrumnet on top of itself or do a 'batch resave' on the Cloud Viola folder (video link below) .

SNAPSHOT INSTALLATION

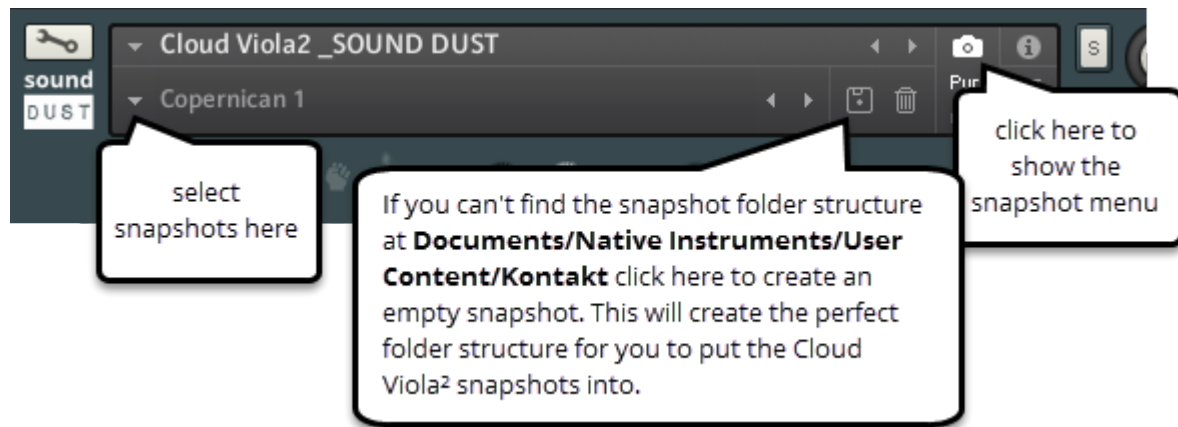
To load the snapshots for Kontakt 5.6.8 and above....

Copy the folder inside the '**CLOUD VIOLA2 SNAPSHOTS- see instructions for installation**' folder to a very special location. It has to be in exactly the right place or your snapshots won't show up.

- On a Mac OS: **Macintosh HD/Users/Your Name/Documents/Native Instruments/User Content/Kontakt**

- On Windows: **C:\Users\Your Name\My Documents\Native Instruments\User Content\Kontakt**

If a 'Kontakt' folder doesnt exist in your 'User Content' folder make one of your own by creating a blank snapshot in Kontakt.
